Emergency Medication: Midazolam *

Designed for people who may need to administer emergency medication for seizures outside a hospital setting.

Topics include:

- Seizure emergencies
- Emergency medication management plans
- Medication administration
- Risk management
- Supporting individuals during emergencies

Prerequisite for Midazolam Training: Epilepsy Essentials completed within the previous 2 years. A current First Aid or CPR certificate is recommended.

Certificate issued upon successful completion. Employers remain responsible for ensuring staff meet workplace requirements and policies for medication administration.



Epilepsy: Learning Impact and Classroom Strategies

Designed for educators to better understand how epilepsy can affect learning, behaviour and classroom participation.

Developed by occupational therapists, neuropsychologists, teachers and epilepsy nurses.
